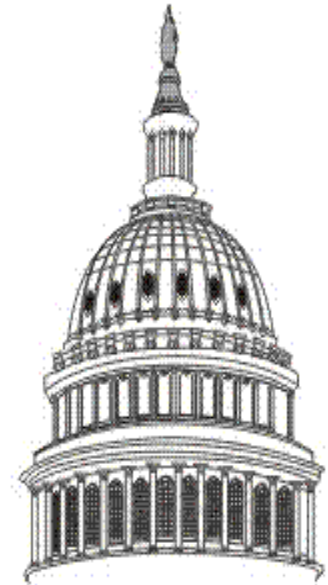

Equal Parents Week Rally

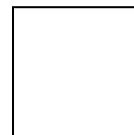

Preparations

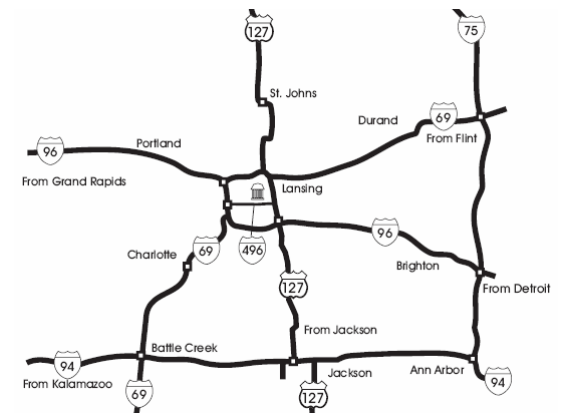
